Reduce Home Fires - Promote Consistent Messages - Improve Data Quality - Provide Valued Resources

Fire Safe SC Community Designations are made annually.

For 2022 consideration, all community goals below must be completed by **December 31, 2022**.

## Track CRR Activities in 2022

- 1. ENGAGE and Build Relationships with Community Stakeholders.*
  - Name of community partner.
  - Type of resource that was requested and/or provided.
  - Quantity of resources received.
- 2. Provide Life Safety Education using Core Four Safety Messages and/or Fire and Life Safety Guides.*
  - Type of group.
  - How many citizens received the message?
  - What message was promoted?
- 3. Report NFIRS monthly (minimum of 6 months) and Improve Data Quality using Dashboard.*
  - Check each month.
  - How did you improve your data quality?
- 4. Community Risk Reduction Courses: Minimum of one in each of the 4 areas below. Provide name of course, completion date, and certificate if received.*
  - NFIRS SCFA 6100, 6200 or NFA Q0494 (new department member not taken before)
  - Home Safety Visit Train the Trainer 8617 (new department member not taken before)
  - CRR Summit 6505 and/or Fire and Life Safety Educator Quarterly 5241
  - All other CRR courses
- 5. Use the NFA Risk Assessment Course, GIS Dashboard, and NFIRS data to identify community risk priorities in your fire district. Be prepared to answer the following questions:*
  - Name the targeted population and or location.
  - List approach used to target the risk area (Flyers, Media, Door to Door, Other).
  - Provide results of campaign.
  - List Core Four or Fire and Life Safety message used.
- 6. Track Outreach Type/Methods used by your department.*
