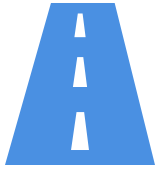


GOLF CART SAFETY



Obey all traffic laws.
Follow the same rules as driving a car.



Use hand signals.

Avoid driving in bad weather, especially if there is lightning.



Buckle up. Install seat belts if needed.



Slow down when approaching and making turns.



Do NOT use a cellphone while driving a golf cart.



Carry no more than 1 passenger per seat.



Keep the keys locked away where only adults have access.



The American Academy of Pediatrics recommends not allowing children younger than 6 years old to ride in a golf cart.

LAWS FOR OPERATING A GOLF CART IN SOUTH CAROLINA



- Possess a valid driver's license (*must be at least 16 years old*)
- Register the golf cart with the SC Department of Motor Vehicles
- Travel only within *4 miles* of the address registered with the DMV
- Stay on roads with a posted speed limit of *35 miles per hour or less*
- Maintain liability insurance on the golf cart
- Drive during daylight hours
- Avoid bike paths
