KEEP AN EYE OUT

- Slow down and keep your eyes on the road.
- Watch for children walking on roadways, medians, and curbs.
- Be careful when entering and exiting driveways.





TRICK OR TREATING

- Have an adult supervise children younger than 12.
- Teach children to never enter a stranger's home or car.
- Inspect candy before allowing children to eat it.
- Limit trick-or-treating to your neighborhood and the homes of people you know.

COSTUMES

- Choose fire-resistant costumes.
- Ensure the costume fits properly to prevent trips and falls.
- Consider using face paint a mask could reduce visibility.
- Give children glow sticks and flashlights to use at night.





DECORATING

- Use flameless LED candles or glowsticks.
- Keep exits clear of decorations.
- Make certain cords are not a trip hazard.
- Don't decorate your house to appear as if it is on fire.
